### Message From Your TDCA

Welcome to Spring, although the last few days have felt more like summer, which is a reminder that we need to prepare our properties for bushfire season. Check our website, www.tyalgum.org.au and look under the Events and Information tab. There is also the latest Bush Fire Land Map for the Tweed, which is used by Council, to ensure new developments have adequate protection from bushfire. Most land in the Tweed is considered bushfire prone with only the more urbanised areas along the coast and larger centres considered not at risk.

Under the same tab is information on Community Resilience, a network of local area coordinators who can assist with communication in times of flood and emergency. The team still needs someone to take on the Back Creek Area. As many will know the Tyalgum Community Hall is our recognised Evacuation Centre and the Community Resilience Leader, currently Mic Julien, operates from there. He can be contacted on 0466 630 050.



### Tyalgum Recreation Reserve and Campground News

It has been quite a busy few months with the campground booked out for the Country Music weekend, followed by the Coastal Acoustic club weekend. With plenty of activity at all other times.

We received a grant to manage weeds on the Crown Lands that we manage, and contract land regenerators, Sam Dawson and Steve Heggie, have begun removing, and/or treating soda apple, Chinese elm, camphor laurel, etc. This project will continue into next year. It is being carried out on the creek bank below the campground, the horse paddock on the corner of Tyalgum Road, and at the Brays Creek Hall creek bank.

Within a few weeks the old fence in front of the General Store and down Balluna Street towards the creek will be replaced. It will be post and rail along Coolman Street and barbed wire cattle fence along the Balluna st. section.




### Christmas Carols 2025


# BALLROOM STARS RETURN TO TYALGUM FOR THE 14th DANCE SPECTACULAR

Tyalgum's red carpet event of the year returns on Saturday, November 15. Now in its 14th year, Hearts Aflame Productions is bringing another glittering evening of world-class Ballroom, Latin and New Vogue dance to our historic Tyalgum Community Hall.
