## **IN AN EMERGENCY WHEN NORMAL COMMUNICATIONS AREN'T WORKING**

1. For UHF communications from outside Tyalgum village to Tyalgum village a Repeater Station is required. The Repeater Station is located at The Lookout on Boxsell Road and is working.
2. The Midland G18 Handheld radio is required, and it must be set to the function 'Repeater'.
3. For communications within your area (line of sight communications) you should use the GME Handheld radios that you have been given, or a similar UHF radio.
4. These radios must be set to the designated channels, see below. For example, within the Yellowwood area the radios, should be set to channel 10 so that people in that area with radios can talk to each other.
